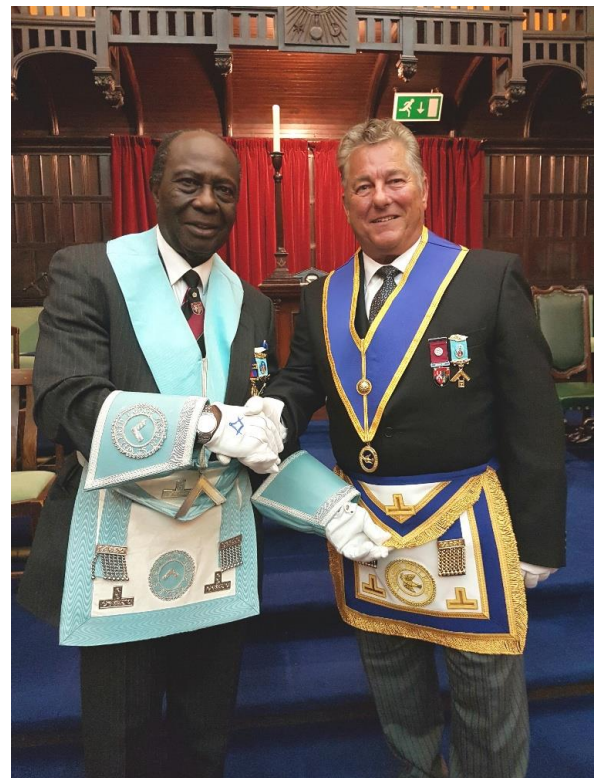
## Memories & Recognitions
